Before You Begin the Semester

- Accept your offer on your application on <u>GradApp</u>
- Create a <u>UA Net ID</u> and set up <u>NetID+/Duo</u>. Make sure to start checking your UA email regularly!
- Send Official Transcripts to transcripts@grad.arizona.edu or, if you applied with an unofficial transcript or have degree updates, to:

This should include any updated classes and a confirmation of graduation

- Complete your <u>FAFSA</u> (domestic students) and apply for <u>College Funding & Scholarships</u>
 - College funding deadlines are March 1 for the fall semester and October 15 for the spring semester
- Log into <u>UAccess Student Center</u> and explore your record, update your address and info as needed, and review any holds on your account
- Complete your <u>online orientation</u> on Brightspace (formerly D2L, you will receive an e-mail and be enrolled soon after accepting admissions)
- Update your bank/direct deposit information on <u>UAccess Employee/Manager</u>
 <u>Self Service</u> if you are hired as a Graduate Assistant or student worker

Register for Classes

- Check the <u>Registration Schedule</u> to see when class registration opens, and find Dates & Deadlines for the upcoming semester
- Sign up for classes check <u>degree requirements</u> on the website as well as <u>student</u> <u>resources</u> and work with your advisors on any questions. Visit the <u>Guide to Register</u> for Classes. All MLIS students are required to take LIS 504 in their first semester.
- Pay all fees and tuition by the first day of classes. See the <u>Bursar's Dates and</u> Deadlines for more info
- Review <u>Enrollment Policies</u>. Full-time enrollment for graduate students is 9 units (or 6 units with a graduate assistantship). Graduate-level classes are at the 500-level and higher.
