  if needed; scholarship deadlines are March 1 for the fall semester and October 15 for the spring
  semester.
- O Visit the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid for information on loans, grants and university scholarships.
- O Log into UAccess Student Center and explore your record, update your address and info as needed.
- O Get your CatCard Student ID.
- O Sign up for classes check <u>degree requirements</u> (link to MS CIO curriculum & courses) on the website as well as <u>advising resources</u>. (link to MS CIO student resources)
- O Read the MS CIO Handbook (link to MS CIO handbook) for all policies and procedures.
